Points are given for activities such as hosting international guests, attending lectures and seminars on and off-campus, touring international companies and organizations (not already on GSP schedule as required events), conducting informational interviews with international business professionals, going to international art exhibits and festivals, foreign films, and other activities that help students better understand global issues surrounding their personal interests. Scholars will receive 1 point per opportunity when they submit a reflection on the international experience with this form. Ten points are required by the end of each year.
